President's report: Jaimie Line

Recap of recent events:

Snack Cart: Students enjoy choosing snacks from our rolling cart. Each item costs \$1, with a maximum of three items per student. We run two carts: one for K–2nd grade and one for 3rd–6th grade. This year, we've added a drink option for older students: sugar-free, dye-free lemonade.

Birthday Fundraiser: We had 192 students sign up this year—a new record compared to 152 last year! For \$5, each student will receive a personalized Happy Birthday message on our Facebook page. At the last Snack Cart of their birthday month, they can choose three free snacks from our snack cart and three trinkets from our birthday bag.

Upcoming Events:

Welcome, Great Pumpkin Raffle: Teachers and office staff will decorate lightweight plastic pumpkins. Students can "vote" for their favorite pumpkins by placing tickets in the jugs of the pumpkins they want to win.

- Every student will receive one free ticket. Additional tickets can be purchased: \$1 for 3 tickets or \$5 for 18 tickets. Tickets go on sale from Oct 13 to 24th. Purchased tickets will be labeled with the student's name and teacher; they will be placed in an envelope and given to their teachers for distribution during the voting week.
- o **Family Night**: Thursday, October 23rd. Families can enjoy cider and donuts, spin a prize wheel for free tickets, and purchase additional tickets to place in the jugs.
- o Winners will be picked on October 30th
- o Flyers will be sent home on October 9th.

Fall Dance: Friday, November 21st. An evening of dancing, a photo opportunity, light refreshments, and a prize drawing. No theme this year—just come to have fun!

Skate Night: Three skate nights are planned this school year. The first event will be held on Tuesday, November 25th, from 6:00–8:00 p.m. at The Rink in Shelby Township.
